Eduardo is currently Principal Consultant at the D Consulting Group, Inc. as well as Founding member and current President of the Internet Society of Puerto Rico, President of the Puerto Rico Broadband Taskforce and Chair of ICANN's North America Regional At-Large Organization (NARALO). His experiences and affiliations include: Professional Engineer (PE) and Member of the Engineering Professional College of Puerto Rico, Member of the Puerto Rico Technological Corridor Advisory Board, Founding member of the ICANN NARALO, NARALO member elected to the ICANN NomCom (2009 & 2010, 2016 & 2017) and ICANN's At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) (2011-2013).
