

# **Alejandra Reynoso**

Alejandra Reynoso holds Master's degree in Computer Science from Universidad del Valle de Guatemala (UVG). Since 2004, she has been a member of the Computer Science faculty in UVG.

In 2011 Ms. Reynoso joined the country code Top Level Domain (ccTLD) .gt (Guatemala) team, as a researcher and technology developer. In the same year she went to her first Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) meeting with the aid of its fellowship program. Alejandra has been involved with this program for more than 5 years, first as a newcomer coach and now formally appointed in 2019 as the country code Names Supporting Organization (ccNSO) Mentor.

As an active member of the ccNSO Ms. Reynoso has been a member of several working groups and committees, such as, the Guideline Review Committee, Study Group on the Use of Emoji as Second Level Domains and ccNSO Meeting Program Committee; she chaired the latter for 3 years. Since 2015, she has been a member of the ccNSO Council as a representative for the Latin American and the Caribbean region, and in 2019 was elected as one of the ccNSO vice chairs.

Alejandra has also been working closely with the Latin American and the Caribbean ccTLDs association (LACTLD), being a long-time member of the Technical Working Group which she is now chairing.
